I. POLICY

It is the policy of the St. Joseph's Hospital and Medical Center (SJHMC) Academic Affairs that the Graduate Medical Education shall function as a committee with a direct reporting relationship to the CMO and the Medical Staff Executive Committee. The DIO in collaboration with the GMEC shall oversee each graduate medical education residency program accreditation policies and functioning insofar as those regulations are not in conflict with hospital general policies, procedures and the medical staff by-laws.

II. PROCEDURES

- A. Program Directors shall be selected by the Academic Chair of the sponsoring department in collaboration with the DIO and Hospital Administration, in keeping with the minimal criteria of each programs' Residency Review Committee.
- B. Program Directors shall have the responsibility to implement both the program requirements as well as institutional requirements of the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education, as well as general policies and procedures within their own residency programs and clinical departments.
